### **HARTFORD POLICE SEEK PUBLIC ASSISTANCE IN IDENTIFYING BURGLARY SUSPECTS; SURVEILLANCE PHOTOS RELEASED**

(Hartford, CT.) Detectives of the Hartford Police Department's North End Burglary Division are seeking public assistance in identifying four burglary suspects believed responsible for the theft of two snow blowers from the Achievement First School, 305 Greenfield Street, Hartford, on February 24, 2013.

The suspects, depicted in the surveillance photos below, are described as follows:

- Suspect #1: Hispanic male or light skinned Black male, 5'4" to 5'6", medium build, wearing a dark green coat and tan gloves, wearing a mask over his face.
- Suspect #2: Black female with shoulder length braids, 5'4" to 5'7", wearing a black coat, skinny black jeans, tan boots, a grey/black hat and tan gloves. Her face is covered with a black scarf.
- Suspect #3: Hispanic male, light skin, thin, wearing a blue jacket with dark blue or black and white stripes on the front, a green hood with dark colored green stripes, black jeans and black shoes.
- Suspect #4: Black male, 5'6" to 5'9", medium build, wearing a brown coat, blue jeans with rips on the front, white sneakers with black stripes on the side, brown gloves and a black mask covering his face.
