The State of Connecticut's Elderly and Disabled Tax Renters Rebate Program will begin April 3, 2018 and end September 28, 2018. Applications will be completed at various scheduled sites within Hartford starting **Tuesday, April 3, 2018**. Please check the enclosed schedule for the site nearest your current address.

In addition, starting July 10th through September 28th, applications will be completed by scheduled appointment only. To make an appointment please call 860-757-4736 **beginning June 25, 2018** between the hours of **8:30AM – 4:00PM** Monday thru Friday.
No calls for appointment will be accepted before June 25, 2018.

Residents eligible to receive Rent Rebate must meet the following requirements:

1. You must be 65 years old by December 31, 2017 or 18 years of age or older and receiving Social Security Disability.
2. You must have rented an apartment or house in CT during 2017 and currently reside in Hartford.
3. Your income in 2017 must not exceed **\$35,300** if single or **\$43,000** if married.

In order to make sure your application is fully completed you **MUST** bring proof of all income and expenses. Please use the check list below to make sure you have the required and acceptable documents. The State Office of Policy and Management (OPM) have instructed staff not to complete any Renters Rebate applications without proof of all expenses and income for year ending **December 31, 2017**. In addition, please make copies of all the expense and income documents that will be used to process your application and be prepared to leave those copies with the designated staff for your file.

- As proof of payment, twelve (12) rent receipts or copies of checks/money orders; or a letter from landlord/property manager detailing total rent paid during the year ending December 2017.
- History payment or summary of payment from gas, electric and oil companies detailing actual amounts paid in 2017. Call the utilities companies, or go on-line, and request a copy be given to you, if needed.

- Proof of all 2017 income, including Social Security, pension, and bank interest.
- Copy of your income tax for 2017 if you filed.
- Proof of your disability allowance in 2017 from Social Security, if you are disabled.

If you are homebound and unable to leave your home without assistance, a family member or friend may act as your representative and have the application completed on your behalf. Due to limited staff, the City of Hartford will not be making home visits.
