This is to certify that at a meeting of the Court of Common Council, April 27, 2015 the following RESOLUTION was passed.

WHEREAS, Rebuilding Together Hartford has been bringing volunteers and communities together to provide free home repairs to low-income Hartford homeowners since 1994; and

WHEREAS, Rebuilding Together Hartford's signature program, National Rebuilding Day, happens every year on the last Saturday in April; and

WHEREAS, Since its inception, National Rebuilding Day has utilized the work of more than 6,500 volunteers who have repaired and revitalized more than 500 Hartford homes; and

WHEREAS, National Rebuilding Day routinely provides free home repair services to between twenty and twenty-five low-income Hartford homeowners each year; and

WHEREAS, National Rebuilding Day utilizes volunteer labor and purchased materials; and

WHEREAS, Depending on the scope of work planned for each home, some projects require a building permit to be issued for a specific home; and

WHEREAS, Permitting fees are costly to a non-profit providing free home repairs; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Court of Common Council hereby authorized the Mayor to waive all permitting fees associated with Rebuilding Together Hartford's signature program, National Rebuilding Day, to be held on April 25, 2015.

This is to certify that at a meeting of the Court of Common Council, April 27, 2015 the following RESOLUTION was passed.

WHEREAS, Section 4-124s as amended by Section 251 and 253 of Public Act 13-247 passed by the Connecticut General Assembly provides statewide incentive grants to regional planning organizations for projects that involve shared services, and

WHEREAS, The Capitol Region Council of Governments (CRCOG) is acting as a convener and facilitator of service sharing projects around the CRCOG region, and

WHEREAS, On November 12, 2014, the Policy Board of CRCOG passed a resolution authorizing development and submittal of an application package to the State Office of Policy and Management (OPM) for funding under the Regional Performance Incentive Grant Program, on behalf of the CRCOG's member municipalities and municipalities of other regions, which are participating in CRCOG initiatives, and

WHEREAS, The Chief Elected Officials and municipal staff of the Capitol Region have developed a list of service sharing project proposals which will benefit individual municipalities and the region as a whole and that have been included in the application package which was submitted on December 18, 2014, and

WHEREAS, The proposed project included in CRCOG's application are:

- 1. Regional Computer Forensics Laboratory,
- 2. Transit Oriented Development (TOD) Study for CTfastrak Corridor,
- 3. Economic Development Grant for the Towns of Bolton, Coventry, Mansfield and Tolland,
- 4. Regional Service Management (CRM) System, and
- 5. Statewide Geographic Information Systems (GIS) Ortho Imagery Flight, and

WHEREAS, The City of Hartford has an interest in taking part in one or more of the project proposals contained in CRCOG's application, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Hartford Court of Common Council does hereby endorse the above referenced Regional Performance Incentive Program project proposals, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Mayor is authorized to execute any and all manner of other documents and to take such other actions as he and the Corporation Counsel may deem appropriate and in the best interests of the City in order to participate in one or more of the above projects, and be it further

RESOLVED, That no person or entity shall be entitled to rely on, or otherwise claim any benefit by reason of this resolution should the Mayor fail to execute the aforementioned agreement or other documents, or to take any of the aforesaid actions, and be it further

RESOLVED, That all approvals and authorizations provided hereby are contingent upon, and only shall be effective on and by means of, the parties executing such documents, and taking such actions, all of which shall be, in form and substance, acceptable to the Mayor and the Corporation Counsel.
